Downtown Century II Utilities Upgrade Project – Walnut Street Lane Closure [Extended October 4] – KUB and its contractor crews will reduce a short section of Walnut Street between Union Avenue and Summer Place to one alternating lane of traffic from 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. on Tuesday, October 4, as work continues on the Downtown Century II Utilities Upgrade project. The northbound lane will be closed, while the southbound lane remains open and is used to alternate traffic through the work zone. Access to area parking garages will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
