Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(West Knoxville) Road Closure – Duncan Road [IMMEDIATE – January 30]** – KUB crews have closed a short section of Duncan Road between Polkwright Lane and Duncans Glen Drive to thru traffic effective immediately, January 30, through late afternoon, as repairs are made to the wastewater system in the area. Alternate routes include Dogwood Drive, Shriver Road, and Crystal Lake Drive. Access to area driveways will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
