(North Knoxville) Edgewood Avenue Road Closure [IMMEDIATE – February 3] — KUB crews have closed a short section of Edgewood Avenue, between Fairview Street and Copeland Street, to thru traffic effective immediately, February 3, through approximately 9 p.m. tonight, as repairs are made to the electric distribution system in the area. Alternate routes include Clearview Street, Nickerson Avenue, and Barton Street. Access to area driveways will be maintained, and follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
