Partial Closure of Neyland Greenway

For Wastewater System Work

KUB crews will close a short section of Neyland Greenway from 6 a.m. Wednesday, December 21, through 6 p.m. Thursday, December 22, as wastewater system repair work is completed. The section of greenway that will be closed is an approximately 1,400 foot segment located along Neyland Drive on the northern bank of the Tennessee River (south of Neyland Drive, across the street from KUB's Kuwahee Wastewater Treatment Plant). All other portions of the greenway will remain open. There is no detour available for the closed section of greenway.
