weather permitting]

(South Knoxville) Alcoa Highway Lane Closure [October 19] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of the curbside, northbound lane of Alcoa Highway at the Governor John Sevier Highway interchange, from 9 a.m. – noon, on Wednesday, October 19, as work is performed on the overhead streetlights in the area. One northbound lane and all southbound lanes will remain open, as will access to Governor John Sevier Highway. Cones and appropriate signage will be on site. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
