Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(South Knox) Chapman Highway Lane Closure [August 24] – KUB crews will close a short section of the curbside, northbound lane of Chapman Highway between Moody Avenue and Taliwa Court from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. on Tuesday, August 24, as repairs are performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. One northbound lane and both southbound lanes will remain open. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

(East Knoxville) W. Magnolia Avenue Lane Closure [August 24] – KUB crews will close a short section of the eastbound lane of W. Magnolia Avenue between N. Gay Street and Williams Street from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. on Tuesday, August 24, as work is performed on the electric system in the area. The westbound lane will remain open to alternate traffic flow through the work zone. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
