- Re: Traffic Advisory Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(North Knoxville) Gill Avenue Lane Closure [September 30] – KUB contract crews will reduce a section of Gill Avenue to one alternating lane of traffic between North Fourth Avenue and North Hall of Fame Drive from 7 a.m. – 4 p.m. on Friday, September 30, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. The eastbound lane will be closed while the westbound lane remains open and is used to alternate traffic. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
