weather permitting]

(West Knoxville) Kingston Pike Lane Closure [Rescheduled - January 12] – KUB crews will close a short section of the curbside, eastbound lane of Kingston Pike, at 3106 Kingston Pike, from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., on Thursday, January 12, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. One eastbound lane and both westbound lanes will remain open during this time. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
