- Re: Traffic Advisory Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(North Knoxville) Charles Drive Road Closure [Extended October 17-20] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Charles Drive to through traffic between Inskip Road and Montrose Road from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, October 17, through Thursday, October 21, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Alternate routes include E. Inskip Road, Fair Drive, Montrose Road, Maple Drive, and Highland Drive. Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

(North Knoxville) Maple Drive Road Closure [Extended October 17-21] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Maple Drive, between Montrose Road and the road's western end, daily from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, October 17, through Friday, October 21, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. All lanes will reopen to traffic outside of listed work hours. Alternate routes include Maple Drive, Horton Road, Highland Drive, and Jenkins Road. Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

(North Knoxville) Road Closure- Montrose Road [Extended October 17-20] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Montrose Road, between Holirose Lane and Maple Drive, daily from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, October 17, through Thursday, October 21, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. All lanes will reopen to traffic outside of listed work hours. Alternate routes include Fair Drive, Rockcrest Road, Charles Drive, and Maple Drive. Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

(Downtown Knoxville) South Central Street Lane Closure [October 17] – KUB crews will reduce a section of South Central Street to one lane of southbound traffic between West Summit Hill Drive and Commerce Avenue, from 9 a.m.- noon, Monday, October 17, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control, and parking access in the area will be maintained. Some street parking spaces may be temporarily inaccessible to facilitate access for utility vehicles and equipment.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use

caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. More information on this and other KUB construction projects can be found at www.kub.org.

Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
