Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

Old Weisgarber Road Closure [Immediate October 28] – KUB crews have closed a short section of Old Weisgarber Road between Middlebrook Pike and Ridgerock Lane effective immediately through 6 p.m. today, Friday, October 28, as repairs are made to the water distribution system in the area. Flaggers and signs are on site to assist with traffic control, and traffic should follow the implemented traffic control plan on site. Alternate routes include Middlebrook Pike, East Weisgarber Road, and Lonas Drive. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
