Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Downtown Knoxville) Locust Street Lane Closure [Extended November 11] – KUB crews will reduce a section of Locust Street to one southbound lane of traffic between W. Vine Avenue and Cafego Place from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., on Friday, November 11, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. One southbound lane of traffic will be maintained. Appropriate signage will be placed on site.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
