## **KUB Celebrates 23rd Arbor Day Tree Line USA Award**

**Knoxville, TN** – Five trees were planted in Governor Ned McWherter/Riverside Landing Park today in honor of Arbor Day by KUB, the City of Knoxville, the Tennessee Division of Forestry, and Trees Knoxville. During the event, KUB received its 23rd consecutive Tree Line USA® award from the Arbor Day Foundation. KUB was recognized with the award for implementing best practices in utility arboriculture through quality tree care, annual worker training, tree planting, and public education.

"In East Tennessee, we are fortunate to have a landscape of trees that provide us beauty year-round from the beautiful fall colors to the cheerful spring blooms," said KUB President and CEO Gabriel J. Bolas II. "KUB remains committed to quality tree care while providing safe, reliable electric service to the community."

KUB maintains over 5,000 miles of electric lines and prunes approximately 1,000 miles of that line each year. In the last year, KUB planted over 400 trees throughout the community. When planted properly, trees can reduce energy consumption, provide beauty, enhance quality of life, and promote clean air and water.
